Action Item	Description	Contact
1	Locate a 120V submersible water pump or a submersible trash pump with a minimum 50mm (2") discharge hose and minimum 190 litre (50 gallons) per minute pumping discharge capacity. If significant water is observed, larger is better.	Coast Equipment Rentals 604-883-2747 Garden Bay Marine Services

	Stabilize the vessel by maintaining greater discharge than incoming volumes of water.	
2	Call Madeira Marine or Liaison Marine Services. Advise them that your hull has been breached and you need an emergency haul-out. If you are unable to equally discharge the incoming	<b>Madeira Marine</b> 604-883-2266

3	If the main engine runs, power the vessel for haul-out only after arrangements have been made. Power the submersible pump with ships generator or portable.
